Syrah

COLOUR

Ruby red with a purple hue.

AROMATICS

Shimmering red fruit and perfumed rose, as well as classic Syrah pepper and spice, with subtle earthy bramble.

PALATE

Black and blue fruits balanced with subtle savoury spice. The palate is of medium body with gentle yet defining tannin to create a silky and luscious cool climate Syrah

AGEING POTENTIAL

10 years +

WINEMAKING

Grapes were picked at optimal ripeness using a selective machine harvester in the cool of the night. The grapes were transferred to large open fermenters where they were allowed to naturally begin fermenting with wild yeast. During ferment, we hand plunged the cap twice per day with one rack and return at its peak. Once sugar dry the must was pressed and after a brief settling period in tank was transferred to seasoned French Oak barrels to complete secondary fermentation and maturation. The wine was kept in barrel for 18 months before blending and bottling.

VINEYARD NOTES

Syrah at Warramunda was planted in 2007 on the gentle north-facing slope of the Estate. Bests Old Block clone was selected to accentuate the hallmarks of this great Coldstream vineyard; fragrant fruit, earthy spice and the silkiest of tannins.
